How does the EU function and which are its governing institutions?


The EU is governed by the principle of representative democracy. Citizens are represented in the European Parliament and member states in the European Council and the Council of the EU.

School Twinning Network Website

Create partnerships (a network) between the schools of Guimarães and the schools of twin towns.

The network operates through a website and an online virtual platform.
